Executive Summary

- Minutes from the previous CRIO Council meeting were approved.
- An update of the Alpine HPC project was provided to the CRIO Council. During the update Michael Miller highlighted the 10 Tb of free storage provided to Researchers and PI at CU-Anschutz. PHI data can be stored in Alpine, but the platform can not be used to store HIPAA data. The Alpine [End User Agreement](#) was shared with the CRIO Council.
- The future of the Slack Grid platform was debated at the CRIO Council and a decision needs to be made if there should be sponsorship, and by which group.
- An update of the Google Workspaces project was provided to the CRIO Council. During the update it was highlighted that the requirements were collected back in November 2022 and the project team is currently providing training to current users and collecting feedback.
