# Key Discussion Points

The key discussion points during the CRIO Council were:

- Bruce Dye and Dallas Martin discussed data sharing across the CU-Anschutz Campus. Bruce Dye and Dalas Martin agreed to address GDPR compliance in their upcoming conversations and are currently working on a project chart.
- Katerina Kechris provided an update on the analytics request Working Group (WG). The WG is actively reaching out to different units to compile a list of available biostatistics services on Campus.
- Slack usage considerations were discussed. Currently, teams across the Campus are using Slack for communication. However, CU Denver will no longer sponsor the Slack enterprise instance, and it will be discontinued on June 6th. It was mentioned that several teams might consider using the free version of Slack. However, Charlotte Russel raised concerns regarding Slack's compliance with data security standards, stating that no HIPAA data should be shared on the platform. The Council Members reached a consensus that a new Slack Grid Instance is unnecessary. They agreed that teams should be allowed to use Slack as long as there is no sharing of HIPAA data, acknowledging that Slack is not approved from a data security perspective.
