## Responsible Conduct of Research

### Virtual Seminar Series

The monthly Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) Seminar Series is re-launching virtually in Fall 2020. We have confirmed with NIH that RCR training conducted via remote access can satisfy the [NIH Requirement for Instruction in the Responsible Conduct of Research](#). To ensure that the training meets these requirements, we'll be making a few changes!

1. **RCR trainings will now run 90 minutes.** This will allow us to provide a full hour of instruction, while allowing time for discussion and facilitation. Attending any 8 out of the 9 RCR seminars we offer will satisfy the NIH training requirement.
2. **We will offer 2 RCR sessions per month** rather than having a single session per month and a make-up week in the summer.
3. Because the NIH requirements for RCR training specify face-to-face discussion, our **attendees will need to keep their cameras on** in Zoom throughout the session.
4. **Get ready for interaction!** We'll be breaking out into small groups to discuss the concepts, taking polls during the session, and distributing an electronic attendance sheet during class.
5. We'll ask that you **be a good Zoom neighbor!** Please follow basic etiquette, like participating in discussions, remaining attentive, and keeping yourself on mute while you're not talking to the group, and using the Chat function to ask questions.

Learners may register for the sessions via SkillSoft by signing into the CU Denver | Anschutz SkillSoft portal with their CU credentials. Class size is limited, so be sure to register early **ONLY** for the sessions you need.
