Guidelines for Transportation of Controlled Substances on the Anschutz Medical Campus

Acceptable containers for transporting controlled substances meet the following criteria:

- Container should be hard-sided and constructed from material allowing easy cleaning and disinfecting between uses.
- Container should have a securely closed lid to contain spills: leak tight for liquids and sift-proof for solids.
- Contents should be closed and protected against movement and damage.
- Contents should be clearly labeled.

Acceptable transportation routes:

Materials can be hand-carried between buildings within campus boundaries with acceptable containers.

Movement of the materials between building floors must be done by using the stairwells or the freight elevator. Passenger elevators must NEVER be used for moving controlled substances.

Transporting materials by vehicle is not permitted.
