PROPOSERS' DAY

The Advanced Research Projects Agency for Health (ARPA-H) will host a Virtual Proposers' Day in support of the Module Announcement ARPA-H-MAI-24-01-03 for the ARPA-H ADvanced Analysis for Precision cancer Therapy (ADAPT) program via webcast on March 15, 2024, from 12 PM ET to 2 PM ET. The purpose of this event is to provide information on the ARPA-H ADAPT program, address questions from potential proposers, and provide an opportunity for potential proposers to consider how their research and clinic efforts may align with the ARPA-H ADAPT program objectives. ARPA-H has posted the Module Announcement for the ARPA-H ADAPT program on SAM.gov.

PROPOSERS' DAY GOALS

1. Introduce the science, technology, and medical communities (industry and academia) to the ARPA-H ADAPT program vision, goals, and technical areas.
2. Provide details regarding the program structure and solicitation requirements for the ARPA-H ADAPT Module Announcement to potential proposers.
3. Encourage submission of questions to the Ask-A-Question link at [ARPA-H Solutions](#). A Questions and Answer forum will take place during the event; however, official answers will only be provided via the [ARPA-H ADAPT webpage](#).

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ARPA-H hosts Proposers' Days to provide potential performers with information on how they may respond to ARPA-H Research and Development solicitations, such as ADAPT to create efficiency in proposal preparation and submission. Proposers' Days are only open to registered potential proposers; therefore, the event is closed to the general public and media.

There is no registration fee for the ARPA-H ADAPT Virtual Proposers' Day. The deadline to register is March 13, 2024, 3:00 PM ET. Virtual Proposers' Day registered attendees will receive an email with the Zoom webinar link and instructions to access the event upon registering.

NOTE: There will be an opportunity for one-on-one meetings with the ARPA-H ADAPT Program Manager (PM), Dr. Andrea Bild on Friday, March 15, 2024, from 2 PM to 5:30 PM ET and Monday March 18, 2024, from 12 PM to 5 PM ET. During the ADAPT Proposers' Day registration process, potential proposers will have the option to request a one-on-one meeting. Only one (1) one-on-one meeting per team will be allowed on a first-come basis. Please coordinate with your team regarding who will request the one-on-one meeting during registration. Upon registering potential proposers who requested a one-on-one meeting will receive an email from the ARPA-H ADAPT team containing a link to schedule the meeting via Microsoft Bookings. Due to limited slots, registration does not guarantee a one-on-one meeting. Each meeting will be limited to ten (10) minutes.

Prior to the one-on-one meeting, potential proposers are encouraged to read the ARPA-H ADAPT Module Announcement posted on [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov) and Questions and Answers posted to the [ARPA-H ADAPT webpage](#) to make the best use of the limited time. The Government reserves the right to cancel or shorten one-on-one sessions for any reason. Once all-time slots have been filled, new requests for one-on-one meetings will be added to the waiting list and proposers will be notified if a slot becomes available. All one-on-one meetings will be handled virtually using Microsoft Teams.

EVENT FORMAT

The ARPA-H ADAPT Virtual Proposers' Day will be hosted via Zoom for Government. All attendees are required to log in using their first and last name. Participants calling in must call from the number provided during registration.

The virtual event will be hosted by ARPA-H ADAPT PM, Dr. Bild, with supporting presentation by ARPA-H leadership and acquisition and contracting experts.
